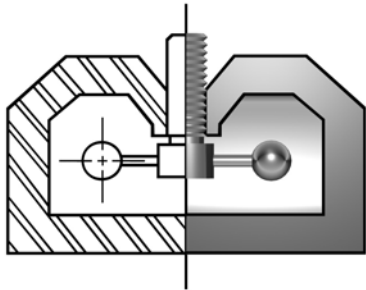

Boeing placed an order for additional tensioners used with the Space Shuttle.

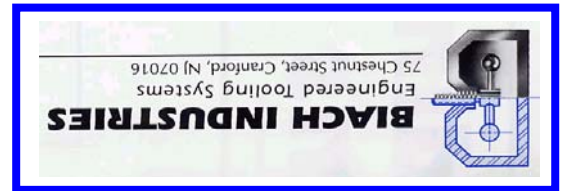
Federal Mogul purchased additional tensioners for its piston ring production facility.

NUCLEAR PLANT ORDERS

***ANGRA (Brazil)** orders EPN Pump and new Communication Box System, along with a spare RPV tensioner.

***Dominion Generation** orders new tensioner housings. Their new, thicker flange for *No. Anna* necessitated new tensioner housings – Biach designed a new housing based on the QD-H design to use with their current tensioner hydraulics and pull system. These, along with an EPN, helped the utility take major steps towards a complete QD-H system that can be shared between two sites.

***Exelon** orders QD-H tensioner package to share at **Byron & Braidwood**. Tensioner design includes new Communication Box System, Hoist and Tractor Control Handles and Biach's new Elongation Monitoring system.

***Florida Power & Light** orders 3 Electric Stud Drive Tools for their *St. Lucie* site and 3 for its *Seabrook* plant. Eight sites have now upgraded to Biach's new Electric Stud Drive Tool.
